Funding


Funds are available in Unappropriated Asset Forfeiture Police Vehicle Training (fund 2902).

BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS


The Police Department maintains an account (FEAP 490) with up to \$25,000 of appropriated Asset Forfeiture funds for the Police Vehicle Training program. This account was established prior to 1999 to alleviate the need to come before Council for routine and minor purchases for driver training purposes, using asset forfeiture funds. When the funds are depleted, staff returns to Council to appropriate funds to replenish the account. The Police Vehicle Training account available balance is \$6,178.59 with a pending purchase that will deplete the account. Staff requests that \$25,000 of Unappropriated Asset Forfeiture Police Vehicle Training funds (fund 2902) be appropriated to replenish the account.


