PRCS


Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) refers to subjects released from PRISON and supervised by the probation department under AB109.

Parolee

Subjects given a conditional release from PRISON and supervised by California Department of Corrections & Rehabilitation (CDCR) Adult Parole Dept.

Probationer

Subject released from the COURTS without prison and supervised by the probation department in the county they reside.



Our Challenge

How do we oversee, manage, and supervise the current and future population of PRCS parolees?

THE CURRENT & FUTURE IMPACT OF REALIGNMENT (AB 109)

Current Impact

- Implemented on 01 Oct 2011.
- 28 individuals released under AB109 in Torrance.
- 67% are a validated gang member/associate.
- 64% have violent criminal convictions.


Additional Impact

- DAPO is maintaining “contact-driven” supervision on high-control and high risk parolees only.
- There are 106 parolees living in Torrance under DAPO supervision.
- 67% are a validated member/associate of a criminal street gang.
- Secondary oversight of parolees will greatly enhance public safety.

**Department of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO)*


Technology

- Requires access to multiple databases.
- Necessary to risk classify, prioritize contact procedures, and deploy resources.
- Intelligence drives decision making.




Negative Impact Of Realignment

- As evidenced by three case studies.



Armed Robberies

- May/2010—two gang members were sentenced to 13 years prison for multiple burglaries committed in Torrance.
- Under AB109, both suspects were released one year later.



Armed Robberies

- Three months after their release, a violent series of armed 'take-over' robberies began.
- Suspects targeted tobacco stores in Torrance and the South Bay.
- There were 5 robberies before an arrest made.

BB-Gun Vandal

- In 2009 there were 192 vandalisms committed by a single individual in the City of Torrance.
- In excess of \$300,000 in damages.
- Methamphetamine was a contributing factor to the suspect's actions.


BB-Gun Vandal

- Arrested/charged with 70 counts of felony vandalism.
- Under AB109, he was released back into our community after serving just two years of a seven year sentence.
- Two months after release, the suspect was arrested for possessing methamphetamine during a parole search.




A Night Prowler

- June/2008, subject sentenced to four years prison for felony vandalism.
- Was already under probation supervision—assault and drug use—when the crime was committed.
- Has a violent criminal history (assault & robbery) and is a methamphetamine addict.




A Night Prowler

- Released one year early under AB109.
- Four months after his release, we received a radio call of a nighttime prowler in the backyard of a private residence.
- Officers arrested the suspect while prowling in the backyard where he was partially clothed and under the influence of methamphetamine.




Current Response

Proactively engage in contact supervision, monitor, and assist PRCS/Parolees.



Personnel

- Gang Detectives are the most logical unit to task with the assignment—reassigned from patrol.
- Built in expertise communicating with prisoners, parolees, & gang members.
- Have already worked parole/probation investigations.
- Have working relationships with multiple agencies including CDCR, Probation, and LASD.
- Are an investigative asset to enforce/prosecute laws independent of violations.



Management Information System

- Multiple databases must be accessed to obtain the appropriate information.
- Gang detectives developed a unique solution to consolidate the critical data into one place.

Implementation & What We've Experienced

- The 'Transient' designation.
- Difficulty in managing all the subjects within our two month operational period.
- Inconsistent sentencing for probation violations—no flash incarcerations to this point.
- 72% of part-1 crimes committed in Torrance are from outside in.
