**SUBJECT: General Services - Authorize sale of surplus/obsolete vehicles.
Expenditure: None**

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the General Services Director that City Council authorize the sale of ten (10) surplus/obsolete vehicles to the Torrance Unified School District (TUSD) for a total of \$11,290.50.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The vehicles listed below have been replaced and/or are now declared surplus or obsolete by the General Services Director, and are at the end of their useful lifecycles. Surplus vehicles are first offered to TUSD at half of Kelley Blue Book wholesale value prior to being sent to auction. Accordingly, TUSD has opted to purchase ten (10) of these vehicles at the prices listed below.

Torrance Municipal Code, Section 21.2.3. METHODS OF DISPOSITION OF OBSOLETE PERSONAL PROPERTY states:

g) Transfer to a Public Agency or a Charitable, Civic or Non-profit Organization. The City Council may authorize the sale, lease or donation of Obsolete Personal Property to the federal government or one of its agencies; to the State of California; to any county, city, school district, special district; other governmental agency; or to any charitable, civic or non-profit organization. The price and terms of transfer must be established by the City Council, but may be made without advertisement for or receipt of bids.


