**SUBJECT: Reconsideration and Possible Consideration of Amending Sections of the
Municipal Code relating to the issuance of Business Licenses**

RECOMMENDATION

It is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council address the issue of reconsideration of your previous action related to a proposed amendment to the Municipal Code relating to the issuance of business licenses. If reconsideration is agreed to, the City Council should address the original item that is attached.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On July 18, 2006, the City Council considered an item to modify the City's Municipal Code relating to the issuance of business licenses. Specifically the proposal was to clarify the Municipal Code to insure that business licenses are not issued for the provision of any service, good, or product that is illegal under California or Federal law.

The ordinance was acted upon by the City Council with Council Members Brewer, Witkowsky and Mayor Scotto voting in favor and with Council Members McIntyre and Sutherland voting no; Council Member Nowatka was absent. An ordinance requires four votes to be enacted so the motion on the ordinance failed.

Council rules allow for a request for reconsideration by the absent member. Council Member Nowatka made such a request at the Council meeting of July 25, 2006. The request for reconsideration is therefore before the Council. If the Council concurs in reconsidering the matter by majority vote, then the item is attached for the City Council's consideration.

SUBJECT: Amending Sections of the Municipal Code Relating to the Issuance of Business Licenses.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Chief of Police recommends that the City Council adopt the attached proposed ordinance clarifying the existing Municipal Code to insure that business licenses are not issued for the provision of any service, good, or product that is illegal under California or Federal law.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

In 1996, the California voters enacted Proposition 215 referred to as the "Compassionate Use Act" which protected patients, caregivers, and physicians who cultivate, use, possess, transport or recommend marijuana for medical purposes. In 2003, Governor Davis signed legislation (SB420) setting forth various criteria for the implementation of Proposition 215. Although granting wide latitude to the distribution of marijuana for medical purposes, the law specifically prohibited any individual or group from cultivating or distributing marijuana for profit.

Numerous marijuana/cannabis distribution centers calling themselves "co-ops" have been appearing in California and have been dealt with in a variety of matters by different cities. Some cities have warmly embraced these "co-ops". Other cities have considered them a land use issue and have enacted a moratorium on licensing them so they can study the secondary effects and determine the appropriate zoning for these distribution centers. However, the Police Department is recommending a different approach. It is recommended that the City Council clarify the City's business license ordinance to ensure that no licenses be issued to individuals seeking to open a marijuana/cannabis distribution business that violates Federal Law.

The United States Supreme Court has ruled that distribution of marijuana for medical purposes is in violation of the Federal Controlled Substance Act. The United States Attorney's Office has recently indicted owners of "co-ops" in the San Diego area.

It should be noted that this Ordinance would not affect the legal status of individual patients who are not involved in unlawful distribution. It is the position of the Department that these "co-ops" are illegal under Federal law and should not be licensed as businesses by the City of Torrance. Therefore, it is recommended that the City adopt the attached ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TORRANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE TORRANCE
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF
BUSINESS LICENSES**

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

That Section 31.3.6 of the Torrance Municipal Code be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“SECTION 31.3.6 UNLAWFUL BUSINESS.

No license issued under the provisions of this Division shall be construed as authorizing the conduct of or continuance of any illegal or unlawful business or practice, or the furnishing, sale, or provisioning of any service, good, or product that is illegal under this Code, the Laws of the State of California, or the Laws of the United States of America.”

SECTION 2

A new section 31.4.1(a)(9) shall be added to the existing Section of 31.4.1 to read in its entirety as follows.

“SECTION 31.4.1. APPLICATIONS.

- a) Every person required to have a business license shall make application to the License Supervisor. The applicant shall furnish all information required to enable the License Supervisor to properly classify the business of the applicant and determine the proper license tax to be paid by such applicant. This information shall include, but not be limited to:
- 1) Name of firm;
 - 2) Address and phone number;
 - 3) Mailing address;
 - 4) Nature of business;
 - 5) Name of applicant;
 - 6) Address and phone number of applicant;
 - 7) Driver's license number of applicant;
 - 8) Social Security number of applicant;
 - 9) An affirmation by the applicant that the business does not furnish or provide any service, good, or product that is illegal under this Code, the Laws of the State of California or the Laws of the United States of America.”

SECTION 3

Any inconsistent provisions of the Torrance Municipal Code or any other inconsistent ordinances of the City are repealed to the extent of the inconsistencies.

SECTION 4

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, then the decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the ordinance. The City Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each of its sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases might be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5

This ordinance will take affect thirty days after the date of its adoption. Within fifteen days following adoption, this ordinance or a summary of this ordinance, if authorized by the City Council, will be published at least once in the Daily Breeze, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.



SUMMARY

On July 18, 2006, the City Council of the City of Torrance adopted Ordinance number _____ amending Sections 31.3.6 and 31.4.1(a) of the Torrance Municipal Code relating to the issuance of business licenses.

The Ordinance clarifies existing language in Section 31.3.6 emphasizing that the issuance of a business license does not authorize conduct or business which violates Torrance, State, or Federal Law.

Section 31.4.1(a) was amended to require that an applicant for a business license affirm that the business will not furnish or provide goods, services, or products that are illegal under Torrance, State, or Federal Law.

Questions and Answers

to Council Agenda Item 11E dated July 18, 2006

Question: Are all businesses in the City of Torrance required to have a business license?

Answer: All companies performing business in the City are required to have a business license. Not for Profit businesses are exempted from paying fees for their license if they have the following:

- (a) Must have a qualifying letter of exemption from the Secretary of State of the State of California and a article of incorporation identifying their non profit status*
- (b) Must have a qualifying letter of exemption from the Internal Revenue Service and from the California State Franchise Tax board*
- (c) Must provide Financial Statements detailing all income and expenses for the past three years when applicable.*

When a business applies for a license in the city, they are categorized as either for profit or not for profit, depending on the type of business and if they have the aforementioned documents.

As a point of clarification, under the City's business license ordinance, the ordinance only affects businesses and not patients or their care providers.

Question: Would existing City of Torrance businesses be required to affirm that their business does not furnish or provide any service, good, or product that is illegal under the City ordinances, the Laws of the State of California or the Laws of the United States of America?

Answer: Yes. Existing businesses will be required to sign an affidavit affirming the above. The affidavit will be mailed to existing businesses during the renewal period in December.

Question: Are there other medical marijuana dispensing facilities located in the South Bay vicinity?

Answer: Yes. There are approximately 13 facilities located in and around the South Bay area, including facilities in Palos Verdes Estates, Redondo Beach, Lawndale, El Segundo, San Pedro and Long Beach. Several of the facilities provide home delivery services.

Some cities have treated this as a zoning/planning issue and it's affects on the community or as a business licensing issue.

Question: How will the business license staff know when a company applies for a medical marijuana dispensing facility that a business license should be issued?

Answer: Business License applicants are now required to sign a declaration stating they are duly authorized to make this application and all of the information provided in this application is true and correct. The business will not provide any service, goods, or products which is illegal under Federal, State, or Local Laws. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct at time of applications.

Should this not be true the business license can and will be revoked.

Question: Would the County of Los Angeles consider assuming the role of dispensing medical marijuana for the County.

Answer: Staff spoke to county representatives and was told that the county is not considering selling marijuana however, the county passed an ordinance outlining restrictions as to where businesses can sell it.
