
As part of the Executive Management Merit pay plan, the City Council determines the pay for this position. Funds for this purpose are included in the 2006-07 adopted budget.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2006-54 SETTING FORTH CHANGES REGARDING THE HOURS, WAGES, AND WORKING CONDITIONS FOR EXECUTIVE AND MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby resolve as follows:

**SECTION I**

That Resolution No. 2006-54 is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION II**

*Effective November 12, 2006*

**ARTICLE 2 – COMPENSATION**

**SECTION 2.1 REFERENCE POINT AND POSITIONS**

City Manager Pay:

Effective November 12, 2006, the City Council set the pay point for the City Manager as \$20,287 per month.

**SECTION III SEVERABILITY**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
