Members of the Council:

SUBJECT: Police: Authorize the purchase and installation of new lockers and the removal and disposal of existing lockers at the Police Department. Expenditure: \$86,373.12

Re: Bid No. B2007-04

RECOMMENDATION

The Chief of Police recommends that the City Council: 1) authorize a purchase order be awarded to Engineered Storage Systems, City of Industry, California, for the purchase and installation of new lockers and the removal and disposal of existing lockers at the Police Department for a total of \$86,373.12, including sales tax; and 2) transfer \$3,873.12 from the Police Department operating budget to FEAP 565 (Replacement of Officers' Lockers Capital Project).

Funding

\$82,500 is available in FEAP 565 and \$3,873.12 in the Police Department's operational budget.

BACKGROUND

The employee lockers at the Police Department were installed in the early 1980's and are deteriorating. They require constant repair due to rust, broken shelves, broken locks and lock mechanisms and are in need of replacement.

ANALYSIS

The Finance Department, Purchasing Division solicited formal bids from qualified vendors and conducted a job walk at the Police Department. Formal bids for new lockers were opened on February 8, 2007. Bid results are as follows:



Engineered Storage Systems in the City of Industry, California, is the lowest responsible bidder.


