WHEREAS, the Victim Support Program's mission is to ensure that support services are accessible to all crime victims in the City of Torrance and to increase their involvement in the Criminal Justice System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Torrance Victim Support Program is designed to assist and educate the local community about the mission of the Victim Support Program in an effort to build a productive and supportive community relationship; and

WHEREAS, the Victim Support Program provides victims with a variety of services offered on a case-by-case basis. The Program also educates and encourages victims to participate in the Criminal Justice System; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, the Torrance Victim Support Program provided crisis intervention, counseling services, court assistance, crime prevention information, case status updates, resource and referrals for 165 victims; and

WHEREAS, the Victim Support Program is focused on providing a range of services to victims, and providing compassionate support to help them through the emotional and difficult situations to assist them on their way to recovery.
