**SUBJECT: ADDITIONS TO TORRANCE MUNICIPAL CODE RE: INFRACTION
OFFENSES AND UPDATE OF THE BAIL SCHEDULE FOR USE BY THE
SUPERIOR COURT**

RECOMMENDATION

The City Clerk recommends on behalf of the City Attorney, Finance Director, Community Services Director, Community Development Director, and the Police Chief that City Council:

- 1) Adopt an **ORDINANCE** amending and restating the Torrance Municipal Code to indicate which citations may be written as infractions, with an Ordinance Summary for publication; and
- 2) Adopt a **RESOLUTION** restating the suggested bail schedule for both misdemeanor and infraction offenses arising from violations of the Torrance Municipal Code and repealing Resolution 2003-154.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Council direction, various ordinances have been adopted since September 23, 2003, when the Council last adopted an Ordinance amending and restating the Torrance Municipal Code to indicate which citations may be written as infractions and adopted a Resolution amending and restating the bail schedule. The previously adopted ordinances are as follows:

Ordinance No. 3553 - Taxicab Franchise:

On December 2, 2003, the Council passed this ordinance to regulate taxicabs that operate within the City. This ordinance enabled the City to: (1) Regulate the number of taxicabs and provide a method of registering all taxicabs permitted to operate within the City's city limits, (2) Provide adequate information regarding the ownership and operation of taxicab businesses franchised to do business within the City, (3) Regulate the operation of taxicab businesses to ensure that their operation does not adversely affect the general welfare, and (4) Regulate taxicab drivers to ensure the safe operation of taxicabs within the City.

Ordinance No. 3665 - Parking of Vehicles, Wagons or Pushcarts from which Food Products or Merchandise are Sold in Parks and Park Parking Lots:

On July 12, 2005, the Council adopted this ordinance to regulate the parking of vehicles, wagons or pushcarts from which food products or merchandise are sold in parks or park parking lots. Specifically, Council adopted a regulation limiting the time these vehicles, wagons or pushcarts could park at a park or a park parking lot, i.e., not more than twenty minutes at any one park or park parking lot during any twenty-four hour period.

Ordinance No. 3680 – Use of the Public Right of WayOrdinance No. 3681 – Maintenance and Replacement of Trees in Parkway

On February 7, 2006 the council adopted ordinances presented by the Community Development Department and the Environmental and Energy Conservation Commission relating to keeping the public right of way clear of blockages and requiring permits for cutting, trimming or removing trees in City parkways.

Ordinance No. 3682 – Tobacco Products on the Beach:

On May 16, 2006, the Council adopted this ordinance to regulate use or consumption of any tobacco product on any beach within the City, which would better protect the general welfare of the residents of the City.

Ordinance No. 3683 - Consuming Alcohol on the Beach, Public Place or City Park; Possession of an Open Container of Alcohol on the Beach, Public Place, City Park or a Posted Premise of an Off-Sale Alcoholic Beverage Licensee:

On July 18, 2006, the Council adopted this ordinance to prohibit both the consumption of alcoholic beverages and the possession of open containers of alcoholic beverages in public places, and to also conform with applicable state constitutional and statutory law.

Ordinance No. 3686 – Oversized Vehicles and Trailers:

On September 12, 2006, the Council adopted this ordinance to regulate Oversized Vehicles and Trailers on public streets and highways within the City. The need for this regulation stemmed from a need to control the growing number of these Oversized Vehicles and Trailers within the City, which also created traffic and public safety concerns.

Ordinance No. 3693 – Parking of Vehicles in Public Parks and Parking Lots Servicing Public Parks:

On April 17, 2007, the Council adopted this ordinance to regulate the parking of vehicles in public parks and parking lots servicing public parks between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. This ordinance was prompted by a growing need to curb graffiti, vandalism and a need to avoid conflicts with other City programs, e.g., the Farmer's Market at Wilson Park.


ANALYSIS

Torrance Municipal Code section 11.2.6 lists the violations that are infractions. Due to the recent adoption of the above-described new ordinances, eight specific code sections have been characterized as infractions; as a result, these sections need to be expressly added to section 11.2.6. The recommendation is to amend and replace section 11.2.6 of the Torrance Municipal Code to reflect the proposed changes.

When a person who is cited or arrested appears in court, he or she may post bail, pending the disposition of the matter. The amount of bail charged by the Judge comes from a suggested bail schedule prepared by the City and submitted to the Court. From time to time, the bail schedule must be updated.

Since the Court uses the suggested bail schedule, it has been determined that a fully restated Resolution would be most helpful, which would include the newly adopted ordinances. For your review, a chart showing the additions and changes is attached.







ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE
AMENDING SECTION 11.2.6 OF DIVISION 1 OF THE TORRANCE
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO INFRACTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL
CODE**

The City Council of the City of Torrance ordains as follows:

SECTION 1

That section 11.2.6 of Division 1 of the Torrance Municipal Code is amended and restated to read in their entirety as follows:

Section 11.2.6 ISSUANCE OF CITATIONS

Those persons holding the job titles enumerated in the Section 11.2.5 may issue citations, if at all, for those violations of the Torrance Municipal Code which are both listed in this section and for which they have the responsibility to enforce.

The following Torrance Municipal Code sections may be enforced by means of the issuance of a citation, pursuant to law, for their violation. Each such section will be for the purposes of the citation, and any subsequent prosecution, an infraction, as provided in Government Code Section 36900.

SECTION 2

Any provisions of the Torrance Municipal Code or its appendices, or any other ordinances of the City inconsistent with this ordinance to the extent of the inconsistencies and no further, are repealed.

SECTION 3

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance. The City Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance will be guilty of an infraction, and upon conviction will be subject to a fine as provided for in Section 36900 of the California Government Code.

SECTION 5

This ordinance will take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption. Within fifteen days following adoption, this ordinance or a summary of this ordinance, if authorized by the City Council, will be published at least once in the Daily Breeze, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
