SUBJECT: Police - Appropriate and allocate asset forfeiture funds to relocate the Firearms Training Simulator (FATS) trailer. Expenditure: \$23,000.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the Police Chief that City Council appropriate and allocate \$23,000 of asset forfeiture funds to relocate the Firearms Training Simulator trailer.

FUNDING

Funding is available in the U.S. Treasury Unappropriated Asset Forfeiture account.

BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS

The Police Department's Firearms Training Simulator (FATS) trailer is located in the north parking lot of the police facility. With the addition of the **Mobile Command Post Vehicle compound** on the east side of the station, it is the Department's desire to move the FATS trailer to the new compound, into an operational support area and away from the employee parking area. A contractor will relocate the power and communications lines. General Services obtained quotes from three contractors. Cypher's Electric was identified as the lowest and most responsible contractor with a bid of \$20,700. Allowing for contingencies, Staff recommends that a project fund of \$23,000 be established to relocate the trailer.


