What is a Regional Transit Center or RTC?

- A transit center provides regional connectivity for all transit agencies in the South Bay and Los Angeles County
- Close proximity to High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Freeway Lanes, Regional Rapid Service and Light Rail (existing and projected)
- Provide convenient point of transfer for passengers to and from other transit agencies or modes of transportation

What Are the Benefits of a RTC in Torrance

- Encourages everyone to utilize public transit
- Eases traffic congestion on main streets and transportation corridors - in turn, improves the region's air quality and reduces fuel consumption
- Makes public transportation more efficient and increases overall mobility
- Provides reliable and convenient transportation for the local work force, student population, senior citizens and disabled passengers

- TTS is seeking Your Honorable Body's conceptual approval to begin this project
- A five acre parcel of land or site would be ideal for a RTC
- A TTS RTC would have bays to accommodate buses on layover and space for a Transit Store – for the sale of fare media and transit route information
- Public amenities would include restrooms, pay phones, bicycle racks and parking for up to 250 vehicles
