**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE HONORING
STEVEN MEDVED
UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE CITY
AFTER THIRTY-FOUR YEARS OF SERVICE**

- WHEREAS,** Steven Medved was hired by the City of Torrance under the Public Employee Program (PEP) on January 1, 1972 upon his return from Vietnam, as a temporary electrical trainee; and
- WHEREAS,** Steven passed the electrician position test and was hired as an electrician by the Traffic and Lighting Department on November 9, 1975; and
- WHEREAS,** Steven was initially trained by the United States Navy performing duties in the repair of pumps and motors and, upon his employment with the City, he was able to troubleshoot and repair many sewer lift stations or other pumps; and
- WHEREAS,** Steven worked in the capacity of an electrician maintaining, repairing or performing any modifications to the electrical systems to assure the safe and efficient operation of all electrical systems in the city buildings; and
- WHEREAS,** Steven has worked in three different City departments, starting with Traffic and Lighting. Later, Traffic and Lighting became a division of Transportation Department and finally, in 1994, the electrical division was transferred to the General Services Department; and
- WHEREAS,** for 34 years, Steven has worked and lived in the City of Torrance, his depth of knowledge in the field of electrical systems and his dedication has helped the City achieve significant savings on electrical maintenance and repair work.

STEVEN MEDVED
