**Members of the Council:**

**SUBJECT: Public Works – Approve the second year renewal option for Purchase Order 2009-269 for Ready Mix Concrete Class “A”, Class “C” and Slurry Mix. Expenditure: Not to Exceed \$312,355.**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Recommendation of the Public Works Director that City Council approve the second year renewal option for Purchase Order 2009-269 with Catalina Pacific Concrete Co. of Azusa, California, for ready mix concrete Class “A”, Class “C” and Slurry Mix, on an as needed basis, in an amount not to exceed \$312,355. The term of the second year will be from August 13, 2009 to August 12, 2010.

**Funding**

Funding is available in the Public Works Department’s 2009-2010 operating budget.

**BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS**

Ready mix concrete and slurry mix (cement and sand mixture) are used by the Operations Division of the Public Works Department on an on-going basis for various street, curb and sidewalk repair projects. In addition, other departments will also utilize this purchasing agreement for their concrete and slurry mix needs. It is essential for the efficient operation of the Public Works Department to have a readily available source for ready-mix concrete and slurry mix.

On August 12, 2008 the City Council approved a purchase order with Catalina Pacific Concrete Co., for ready mix concrete Class "A", Class "C" and Slurry Mix, on an as-needed basis, for a one (1) year period as the result of Bid B2008-34. The bid document included a renewal option for a second year with terms and conditions unchanged. Catalina Pacific Concrete Co. and the City of Torrance have both agreed to the second year option. Staff continues to be pleased with the product and services provided by Catalina Pacific Concrete Co.
