Members of the Council:

SUBJECT: General Services – Authorization to award a Purchase Order to Turf Star Inc for the sole-source purchase of Toro brand lawnmower replacement parts.

Expenditure: Not to exceed \$ 45,000.00

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the General Services Director that City Council authorize the award of a purchase order to Turf Star Inc. of Brea, CA in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 for the sole-source purchase of Toro brand lawnmower replacement parts on an “as requested” basis, effective October 6, 2009 through October 5, 2010.

Funding

Funding for purchase of lawnmower replacement parts is available in the FY2009-2010 and FY2010-2011 Fleet Services Operating Budget (Warehouse Inventory Account).

BACKGROUND

The Fleet Services Division requires lawnmower replacement parts in order to maintain and repair the Toro brand lawnmowers used by the City for landscape maintenance. The majority of lawnmower parts used on a regular basis are stocked in the City Warehouse. An annual purchase order allows staff to quickly order non-stocked parts and replenish warehouse stock.


ANALYSIS

Turf Star, Inc. is the only authorized distributor of Toro brand commercial lawnmower parts in the State of California. Turf Star stocks a large selection of Toro parts at their Brea facility and is able to provide lawnmower replacement parts to the City as our needs arise. Turf Star provides timely delivery of all orders, enabling the Fleet Services Division to minimize equipment downtime.

Torrance Municipal Code, SECTION 22.3.17. EXCEPTION; SOLE-SOURCE PURCHASES, paragraph b) states: "For purposes of this Section, "sole-source purchases" means those purchases where it would be undesirable or impossible for the City to advertise for bids for particular work or for patented items, or experimental or unique services or products, or where competitive purchases would be unavailable or would not prove advantageous for the City."


