SUBJECT: General Services – Authorize a purchase order for four (4) Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors.

Ref: Bid B2009-40

Expenditure: \$91,153.84 (includes Sales Tax, Tire and Delivery Fees)

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the General Services Director that the City Council authorize a purchase order to Power Ford Torrance of Torrance, CA in the amount of \$91,153.84 for the purchase of four (4) Model Year 2010 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor (CVPI) patrol sedans for the Torrance Police Department.

Funding

Funding is available in the FY 2009-2010 Fleet Services Vehicle and Equipment Revolving Fund.

BACKGROUND

Torrance Police Department (TPD) has four (4) CVPI's currently scheduled for replacement based upon the City's 4-year or 75,000 mile replacement eligibility criteria for patrol vehicles.

Vehicles to be replaced are as follows:


On October 8, 2009, formal bids were opened and the City received 6 bids as follows:


