


Public Hearing Process



Per the Prop 218 Supreme Court ruling of 2006, property related fee increases must follow these procedures:

- Notice by mail to affected property owners and tenants**
- Conduct public hearing no less than 45 days after mailing notice**
- Consider written protests. If over 50% and meet criteria, fee cannot be imposed. If under 50%, Council retains discretion to decide.**

Fee Detail



Sanitation Fee Increase: \$5.86/month

- **From \$22.29/month to \$28.15/month**

Qualifying Senior and/or Permanently

Disabled Low Income Fee Increase:

\$1.48/month

- **From \$8.24/month to \$9.72/month**
