Subject: Finance, City Treasurer - Resolution adopting a restated recommended Torrance Municipal Code Bail Schedule

Recommendation of the Finance Director and the City Treasurer to adopt a **RESOLUTION** repealing Resolution No. 2008-85 and adopting a restated recommended Torrance Municipal Code Bail Schedule.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Torrance Municipal Code Bail Schedule is a comprehensive list of infractions and misdemeanors that incur bail penalties in the City of Torrance. The schedule includes all parking and moving violation rates. The resolution lists the fees for all infractions however, the parking citations are the only fees that are being revised and are listed separately in Attachment B. The parking violation rates have changed over recent years due primarily to state legislative actions assessing surcharge amounts to the rates to fund various courthouse construction projects.

Recent History

In 1994, the state mandated that parking-citation processing responsibilities be transferred from the courts to the local issuing agencies. The transfer of responsibility also decriminalized parking violations and made them civil violations enforced by the local issuing agency. Prior to the transfer, under Government Code section 76000 the state had imposed a parking penalty surcharge of \$5 on each parking citation that the court collected. These surcharges were collected to fund the Courthouse Construction Fund and the Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Fund.

When responsibility for processing parking violations transferred to local governments, the state mandated the collecting agencies, such as the City of Torrance, to continue collecting the \$5 surcharge and remit the proceeds as a pass through to the County and State. The City increased the parking to include the \$5 surcharge which it has been remitting to the State.

In January of 2003, government code GC 70372(b) was issued which increased the surcharge by an additional \$1.50 per citation bringing the amount due to the LA County Superior Court to \$6.50. The City's parking citation processor challenged the validity of the additional surcharge amount and concluded that each agency had to make a decision as to whether they should pay the additional surcharge. The City decided to pay the surcharge since it is a pass-through amount and the ultimate cost is to the parking violator. The city began remitting the additional \$1.50 in January of 2009.

In 2008, the Legislature passed Senate Bill SB 1407, which became effective January 1, 2009, which increased the surcharges by an additional \$3.00. The additional \$3.00 surcharge was also to be used to fund the Courthouse Construction Fund and the Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Fund.

With the passage of SB 1407, the amount the City is now required to collect and pass through to the County and State for each parking violation has increased from \$5.00 to \$9.50. Unless the City increases its parking citation amounts to collect the additional state-mandated surcharges from parking violators, the City will have to absorb the cost from existing parking-citation revenues.

The initial surcharge of \$5.00 per citation generates an approximate \$139,000 annually which the City remits to the LA Superior Court. The additional \$4.50 is estimated to be approximately \$125,000 which is not budgeted. The projected loss of revenue for this fiscal year if your honorable body approve and implement the increase before December 31, 2009 would be approximately \$62,500. The following is a recent history of the parking fee budget, actual revenues collected and actual citations issued for the last five years:


As noted in the June 30, 2009 figures presented above, actual revenues collected were less than budget by approximately \$164,000. The decline in revenues was due primarily to the pass

through surcharge fees and a decline in citations issued. If the parking rates do not increase, potential significant negative variance would continue.

Staff is recommending that the bail schedule be approved adding the pass-through amounts of \$4.50 to all parking citations.





RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2008-85 AND ADOPTING A RESTATED RECOMMENDED TORRANCE MUNICIPAL CODE BAIL SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, violation of the Torrance Municipal Code are infractions or misdemeanors pursuant to City Charter; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 1269b, subdivision (d) provides that the Superior Court Judges shall determine the appropriate bail for all misdemeanor and infraction offenses; and

WHEREAS, the City collects parking fines, fees and penalties, as listed on a bail schedule, for all parking offenses within the City boundaries.

WHEREAS, the City must remit a portion of these parking fines, fees and penalties to the Los Angeles County Superior Court for deposit in County and State funds to be used in facilities construction and other critical needs of the court system.

WHEREAS, the State has increased the amount that must be remitted by the City for each parking offense.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to increase their parking fines, fees and penalties so as to pass through the required remittance amount to those committing the parking offense.

WHEREAS, a bail schedule has been adopted for the City of Torrance;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Resolution 2008-85, adopted June 24, 2008, is hereby repealed and replaced as follows on pages 2 - 23 of this document.

SECTION 2: The City of Torrance requests that the judges of the Southwest District Court of the County of Los Angeles adopt the following bail schedule for violations of the Torrance Municipal Code.
