SUBJECT: Community Services – Approval of 2009-10 Grant Funding for Non-Profit Social Services Agencies.

Expenditure: \$41,530

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Community Services Director that City Council approve a total of \$41,530 for twenty applicants for the year 2009-10 Grant Program for Non-Profit Social Services Agencies.

Funding

There are sufficient funds (\$41,530) available for this program in the Parks and Recreation Commission Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-10.

BACKGROUND

The City of Torrance *Non-Profit Social Services Agencies Grant Program* has been providing grant funds to non-profit agencies for 25 years. Coincidentally, twenty five applicants applied by the deadline for this fiscal year's 2009-10 grant program.

In the past, City Council has allocated \$40,000 toward the grant program. At the recommendation of the *Parks and Recreation Commission*, at the June 2, 2009 meeting, City Council approved the re-allocation of \$1,530 in unspent funds from FY 2007-08 toward the FY 2009-10 Grant Program, making \$41,530 in total funds available for FY 2009-10 (Attachment A). These unspent FY 07-08 funds were from grant recipient *New Life Advocacy* who, due to timing issues, were unable to spend the full amount of grant funds they had received.

ANALYSIS

Attachment B is a summary of the twenty-five FY 2009-10 grant applicant projects submitted for consideration. Of the twenty-five applicants, twenty are being recommended for funding (Attachment C). Due to various reasons, five applicant proposals are not being recommended for funding by the Commission, including the Torbots Robotics Team that was disqualified for not having non-profit 501(c)3 status as required and identified in the grant program application materials.

The following analysis summarizes the FY 2009-10 Grant Program processes undertaken by the *Parks and Recreation Commission*:

- An announcement for the FY 2009-10 Grant Program was published in the Daily Breeze on August 16, 2009 (Attachment D). The Grants Committee consisting of Commissioners Gilbert, Robbins, and Taniguchi conducted interviews with applicant agency representatives on October 13 and November 3, 2009. The interviews included presentations from each agency, as well as clarification of any Grant Committee questions of the applicant.
- On November 4, 2009, the Grants Committee met to deliberate and formulate their recommendations for presentation to the full body of the Parks and Recreation Commission. In evaluating each applicant's proposal and presentation, the Grants Committee evaluated and recommended funding they felt would best serve Torrance residents.
- Each of the FY 2009-10 *Non-profit Social Services Agencies* being recommended for funding was unanimously approved by the Parks and Recreation Commission at their meeting on December 9, 2009. An excerpt of meeting minutes is provided (Attachment E).

A Community Services Department staff committee also conducted a review of the FY 2009-10 *Non-profit Social Services Agencies Grant* applicant proposals. Based on the analysis of the grant applications and after hearing applicant presentations at the Parks and Recreation Commission Grants Committee interviews, staff were in concurrence with the funding recommendations proposed by the Grants Committee to the full body of the Parks and Recreation Commission.

Finally, in order to evaluate past and the current proposed grant allocations, a matrix identifying a 10 year funding history from 1999 to 2009 is attached for review (Attachment F).


