RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the Community Services Director that City Council subsidize fees in the amount of \$660.00 for the Second Annual Rotary Club of Del Amo Soccer Tournament to be held at Columbia Park on Saturday, June 5, 2010.

Funding


Funding in the amount of \$660.00 is available in the City Council's Municipal Legislative Policy Program Budget. A total of \$4,845.65 remains out of an annual budget of \$10,000.00 for subsidy of community events. If approved, the remaining balance will be \$4,185.65.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Rotary Club of Del Amo has secured a permit to hold its Second Annual Soccer Tournament at Columbia Park. A letter requesting the waiver of fees associated with the permit was received from Ralph Seifer, the President of the Rotary Club of Del Amo (Attachment A). This year marks the second annual tournament, an event the Rotary Club hopes to support for years to come. The permit fees of \$660.00 represent the maximum costs associated with all fields for a one day tournament. The Community Services Director supports this tournament and recommends the approval of the subsidy of fees.


