WHEREAS, everyday these courageous men and women risk their lives as they encounter increasing dangers in order to keep the streets and neighborhoods of Torrance crime free and safe; and

WHEREAS, "BLUE RIBBON WEEK" is a time in which the citizens of Torrance show their support and gratitude to the men and women in Law Enforcement; and

WHEREAS, on Peace Officers' Memorial Day, the citizens of Torrance pay tribute to the men and women who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Frank Scotto, Mayor of the City of Torrance, California, do hereby proclaim May 9-15, 2010, as

BLUE RIBBON WEEK

in the City of Torrance, and further proclaim May 15, 2010 as *California Peace Officers Memorial Day* in Torrance, encouraging all citizens to remember those individuals who gave their lives for our safety and express appreciation to those who continue their important work of making Torrance a safer place in which to live, work and play.
