Dear Mayor Scotto,

By now you've probably received a number of communications regarding the naming of the park in the Seaside area located between Kathryn Ave. and Anza Ave. I've read with great interest the updates provided via email from Tom Rische, president of our local homeowner's association who has reported on the Parks & Recreation Commission meetings and their final recommendations to you and the City Council.

I am writing to you now because of a grassroots effort by local residents to honor Joe Anzack, Jr., Matt Ferrara and Micah Gifford in the naming of this park. I have read the Commission has forwarded their three final suggestions to the Council for a vote next week. (Las Brisas, Esperanza and Seaside). I am aware the final decision of naming is up to you and the City Council and alternate names may have been suggested in this effort. In addition to your final decision, I would like to ask for your support to include a memorial plaque in the park honoring these young men and trees planted in their honor.

The effort to honor these young men is far reaching. A personal friend from Washington, D.C. also received the email to contact you. Mike Yaguchi works in the Pentagon and worked in the office of the Joint Chief of Staff when Joe was killed. While he never knew Joe, he was very helpful to the Anzack Family and periodically visits Joe at Arlington Cemetery sending the family photographs at Christmas (wreaths on every headstone is a breathtaking sight). Mike copied me on the email he sent to you and it motivated me to write to you.

The lives of these young men have touched our family personally. My children knew them. Joe and

Matt went to Seaside, Calle Mayor and South with our children. Gary and I know their families. Our daughter knew Micah at South High. These are boys who grew up in the neighborhood and their lives touched us. It is very fitting to include their memory in this local park.

I am confident you and the City Council will find a way to make it happen.

Our family **does not** support "JOSEPH, MATTHEW, AND MICAH PARK" as the name for the new park on Anza and Catherine. We live very close to this new park (4840 Mindora Dr.) and feel that this name is too long and difficult for children to remember.

We support "Seaside Park" as our first choice. We also like the other two names, "Las Brisas," and "Esperanza."

We understand that the people bringing forth this name want to remember our fallen soldiers. Our two children, Veronica Calkins and Rex Calkins, recently graduated South High School and attended during the times that these soldiers were killed. They also attended Seaside Elementary School and Calle Mayor Middle School. South High has recognized these soldiers with permanent placks in the school mall, permanently attaching their football numbers on the sides of the football stadiums in large numbers with their names engraved below, retiring their football numbers, creating a digital marquee sign that has their names permanently engraved in large letters, etc.

Our community has done a lot to support these young soldiers, and though it is a nice thought to also name a park after them, it is lengthy, difficult to say quickly, and is not easy to remember. When children speak to their parents, it is much more difficult to say, "Lets go to JOSEPH, MATTHEW, AND MICAH PARK," than "SEASIDE PARK," or the two others.

Please keep these issues in mind while discussing the name for the new park.

We understand that the people bringing forth this name want to remember our fallen soldiers. Our two children, Veronica Calkins and Rex Calkins, recently graduated South High School and attended during the times that these soldiers were killed. They also attended Seaside Elementary School and Calle Mayor Middle School. South High has recognized these soldiers with permanent placks in the school mall, permanently attaching their football numbers on the sides of the football stadiums in large numbers with their names engraved below, retiring their football numbers, creating a digital marquee sign that has their names permanently engraved in large letters, etc.

Our community has done a lot to support these young soldiers, and though it is a nice thought to also name a park after them, it is lengthy, difficult to say quickly, and is not easy to remember. Honorable City Council:

Regarding park naming suggested in the Aug. 9 Breeze, we speak strictly as individuals:

We'd prefer a name clearly connected in some way with the area it serves. Of the three names presented by the P&R Commission, Seaside meets that test. One reservation: it sounds a lot like nearby Sea-Aire Park/Golf Course.

In a sense, Anzanita, a name suggested by some 30 Seaside residents at a special meeting about facilities in the park, at least gives some clues as to where it is located. The P&R Commission didn't see fit to include that among the finalists, preferring instead Seaside, Esperanza (hope) and Las Brisas (breezes).

Personally, we are troubled by "exotic-sounding" Spanish names like Sur la Brea, Las Canchas, Alta Loma, or Los Arboles (now better known as Rocketship Park). which give no clue as to where they are. They are easier found these days for those with GPS.

And for us, naming facilities after people, no matter how worthy they may be, causes difficulties for many individuals to locate. We'd prefer a facility named for its location--with some dedication or tiles inside to individuals or causes:

We would have preferred, for instance, the name, West Torrance Library, (dedicated to Torrance's first Librarian, Isabella Henderson). Or the Torrance Plunge, (dedicated to Councilman Victor Benstead and his wife Gladys). Or the Los Angeles County Civic Center, (dedicated to Kenneth Hahn). Etc., Etc. and so forth. Perhaps names should wait

until five or ten years after their deaths to put them in perspective. But then there is a problem of those who donate lots of money. . .?

What will the names of public facilities mean to Torrance residents in 2020 or 2050?
