BACKGROUND/ ANALYSIS

In the past, this workshop had been held in the City Hall West Annex Commission Room. However, in 1999 several returning Youth Council members that had served for several years and had experienced the workshops at the West Annex before suggested a different venue for the workshop for returning and newly appointed Youth Council members.




