**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Ruben Carbajal was hired by the City of Torrance under the Public Employee Program (PEP) on February 7, 1972 as a maintenance trainee in the Building Maintenance Department; and

WHEREAS, Ruben continued his education and hands-on training at Long Beach City Collage in the electrical field, and applied for the position of Electrician. Upon passing the exam, he was promoted to Electrician within the Transportation Department on September 11, 1977; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, Ruben transferred to the General Services Department as part of a City reorganization of electrical functions; and

WHEREAS, Ruben was a dedicated and hardworking employee. Due to his continued commitment and outstanding performance, he received many accolades and thank you letters from other departments as well as his supervisors during his 36 years of City service.
