**BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS**



The City is one of 26 finalists for the All-America City Award, sponsored by the National Civic League, a nonpartisan nonprofit organization that strengthens democracy by increasing the capacity of the nation's people to fully participate in and build health and prosperous communities across America.

Public hearings and budget workshops for the City's 2011-2013 Two-Year Operating Budget were originally scheduled for June 7<sup>th</sup> and June 14<sup>th</sup>. To accommodate Councilmembers attending the All-America City Award, the hearings and workshops have been rescheduled for June 7<sup>th</sup> and June 21<sup>st</sup>.


