**Members of the Council:**

**SUBJECT: City Manager - Approve subsidy of fees for the use of Torrance Park by the California Army National Guard Armory. Expenditure: \$412.50.**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Recommendation of the City Manager that City Council approve subsidy of fees in the amount of \$412.50 for the use of Torrance Park by the California Army National Guard Armory for a Family Day Celebration to be held on Saturday, June 18, 2011, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Funding

Funding is available in the City Council's Municipal Legislative Policy Program Budget. A total of \$5,139.97 of the annual budget of \$10,000 remains in the budget for subsidy of community events for this fiscal year. If approved, the remaining balance is \$4,727.47.

**BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS**

At the City Council meeting on March 24, 2011, Council Furey requested concurrence of Council to direct staff to bring an item forward to consider a subsidy of the rental fees for the use of Torrance Park on Saturday, June 18, 2011 for a Family Day Celebration hosted by the California Army National Guard Armory.

Some of the soldiers from the California Army National Guard Armory Unit located in Torrance were deployed to Iraq in January of this year. The California Army National Guard Armory wants to host a family picnic to have soldiers and their loved ones spend time together. The event is scheduled for Saturday, June 18, 2011 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. The event will include food, fun activities, and ball games for all family members and soldiers to enjoy.


The current budget for Community Events provides \$10,000 annually to subsidize certain events.
