SUBJECT: City Manager - Accept and appropriate \$ 12,000 in donations from ExxonMobil Corporation to support City programs.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the City Manager that City Council accept and appropriate a \$12,000 donation from ExxonMobil Corporation as follows:

- 1) \$10,000 to support the Torrance Fire Department Community Emergency Response Training Program (CERT);
- 2) \$1,000 to support the Library Science Month Reading Program; and
- 3) \$1,000 to support the Library Youth Services Program

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Through the years, ExxonMobil Corporation continues to exhibit its commitment to the community, especially through long standing support of the City's emergency preparedness efforts and various City Library youth programs.

Since 2002, ExxonMobil Corporation has supported the Community Emergency Response Team program often referred to as the CERT Program. ExxonMobil continues to contribute to support the CERT Program and values the benefits it provides to the community. With this generous contribution of \$10,000, the program can purchase equipment for the CERT program.

ExxonMobil Corporation is dedicated to the future of our youth and has supported various programs designed to educate our youth. The donation of \$1,000 to support the Library Science Month Reading Program and the donation of \$1,000 to support the Library Youth Services Program demonstrate their on-going commitment to the youth of our community.

The City Manager request that City Council accepts this generous donation of \$12,000 from ExxonMobil Corporation in support of the CERT Program and educational youth programs through the Community Services Department.
